Who we are and our website

- This website is under the care of Eventually Cornwall and this cookie policy relates to your use of said website – <https://www.eventuallycornwall.co.uk>

What are cookies?

A cookie is a tiny text file that is placed onto your device (e.g. computer, smartphone, or another electronic device with internet browsing capabilities) when you use our website. These help us recognise you and your device and store some information about your preferences or past actions.

For example, we may monitor how many times you visit the website, which pages you go to, traffic data, location data and the originating domain name of a user's internet service provider. This information helps us to build a profile of our users. Some of this data will be aggregated or statistical, which means that we will not be able to identify you individually.

You can set your browser not to accept cookies and the websites below tell you how to remove cookies from your browser. However, some of our website features may not function as a result, and your browsing experience will be less tailored according to your engagement on the Eventually Cornwall website.

Our use of cookies

We use cookies on this website to:

- Recognise you whenever you visit us virtually (this speeds up your access to the website as you do not have to log in each time);
- Obtain information about your preferences and use of our website;

How to turn off cookies

Not a fan? No problem. If you do not want to accept cookies, you can change your browser settings so that cookies are not accepted by default. If you do this, please be aware that you may lose some of the functionality of this website. You may select which cookies to allow, block or delete (in whole or in part) through the specific functions of your browser. However, if all or some of the cookies are disabled, the website may not be available or may not work properly and you may be forced to change or manually enter some information or preferences each time you visit the website.

Types of cookies

The cookies we place on your device can be categorised as so:

Session cookies:

These allow our website to link your actions during a particular browser session. These expire each time you close your browser and do not remain on your device afterwards.

Persistent cookies:

These are stored on your device in between browser sessions. These allow your preferences or actions across our website to be remembered. These will remain on your device until they expire, or you delete them from your cache.

Strictly necessary cookies

These cookies are essential for you to be able to navigate our website and use its features. Without these cookies, the services you have asked for could not be provided.

Performance cookies

These cookies collect information about how you use our website, e.g. which pages you go to most often. These cookies do not collect personal data about you. All information collected by these cookies is aggregated and anonymous and is only used to improve how our website works.

Functionality cookies

These cookies allow our website to remember the choices you make (such as your user-name, language, last action and search preferences) and provide enhanced, more personal features. The information collected by these cookies is anonymous and cannot track your browsing activity on other websites.

Targeting cookies

Also known as advertising cookies, these cookies are used to deliver adverts more relevant to you and your interests. They are also used to limit the number of times you see an advertisement on our website and help measure the effectiveness of the advertising campaign. They are usually placed by advertising networks with the website operator's permission. They remember that you have visited a website and this information is shared with other organisations such as advertisers, resulting in a browsing experience that's more 'you'.
